Background

Summary: In order to support student and staff populations on the access campuses, there is need for additional programming and services in areas such as bystander intervention training, classroom inclusivity and climate support, Peer Body Project, academic advocacy for survivors of sexual violence, support of student parents (and others). Budget of \$25,000 will provide programming to each campus over the course of the academic year.


