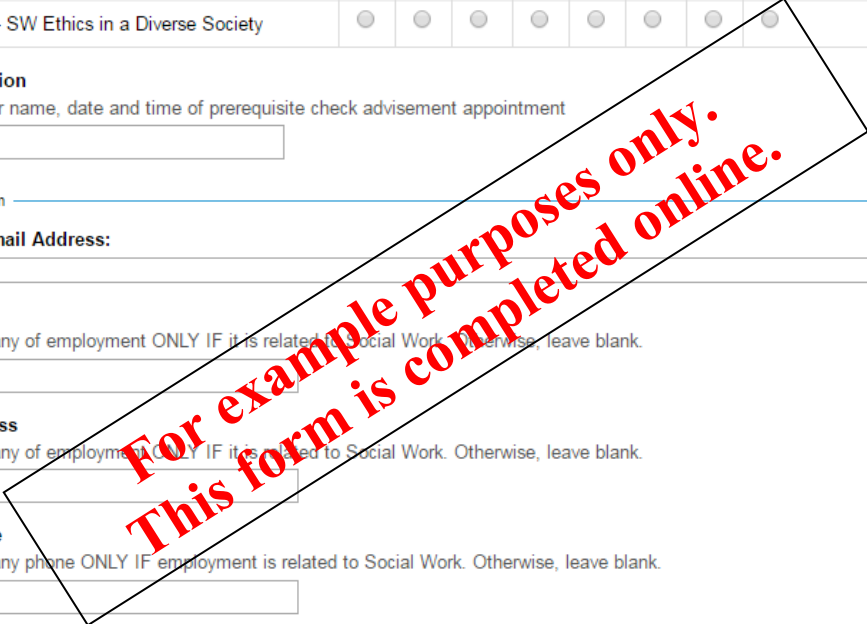

- I likewise understand that I have a further obligation under the Code of Ethics, Section 4.08(b) to seek professional help or take other steps necessary to protect clients and others when these problems or difficulties interfere with my professional judgment and performance.
- I understand that making false, incomplete, or deceptive oral and written statements in the application process may result in denial of admission or dismissal from the program.
- I am aware that it is customary for social service agencies to require BSW or MSW hires or social work interns to submit background checks which may proscribe employment or placement. These background checks address convictions including guilty pleas for the following:

- Driving while intoxicated conviction within last two years
- Felony convictions
- Sexual exploitation of a child or other related offenses
- Drug manufacturing or sale
- Promoting prostitution, sale or purchase of a minor
- Elder abuse
- Physical neglect or injury of a child
- Underage drinking
- Arrests for shoplifting/petty theft and petty larceny less than five years ago
