(Fee will increase Sept 1, 2019 to \$112 per test.)</p> <p>This test center requires a nonrefundable registration fee of \$20 (fee will increase Sept 1, 2019 to \$25) (payable to UW Oshkosh), along with this registration form. Indicate below which test date/time you plan to attend. The mailing address is listed in the upper left hand box at the top of this form. If you need an alternate test date or time, please list your preference in the other column. We will contact you to arrange an alternate date and time. All CLEP examinees will receive a confirmation message after we have confirmed the appointment.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><u>If you cancel or reschedule your exam, the \$20 fee (\$25 fee as of Sept 1, 2019) will not be refunded!</u></p> <p>The other fee for each CLEP exam is \$87. All candidates (with the exception of certain test takers with disabilities) must register and pay their exam fee via My Account at https://clepportal.collegeboard.org/myaccount prior to the date of their scheduled exam. Once a candidate registers and pays the exam fee via My Account, he or she will be able to review/print the CLEP Exam Registration Ticket. In addition, the candidate will also receive an automated email confirming the registration and notifying him/her to print the registration ticket (registration ticket is REQUIRED to bring with you when you take the test), along with other pre/post test day reminders. A CLEP registration is valid for six months; the expiration date will be printed on the ticket.</p>
