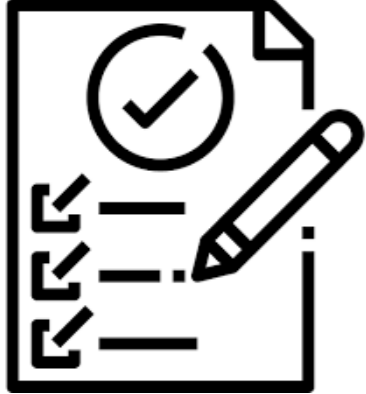

Applying for Transferred Post-9/11 GI Bill Benefits through VA.gov

The following steps outline the process for applying for Transferred Post-9/11 GI Bill benefits

1 Gather Required Information



- Social Security Number
- Bank account information (for direct deposit)
- Your relationship to the veteran (spouse, child, or surviving dependent)
- Veteran's information (name, Social Security Number, VA file number)
- School information (UW Oshkosh program details)

2 Access a VA.gov Account



- Visit va.gov
- Sign in using Login gov, ID me, or DS Logon account
- If you don't have an account, follow the prompts

3 Start the Application



- Navigate to "Apply for Education Benefits" section
- Select Form 22-1990E (Application for a family member to use transferred benefits).
 - Select "No" to indicate that you are not a Veteran or Service member claiming a benefit based on your own service.
 - Select "No" to indicate that your sponsor is not deceased, 100% permanently disabled, MIA or a POW.
 - Select "Yes" to indicate that your sponsor has transferred their benefits to you.

4 Complete the Online Form



- Fill out all required sections:
 - Personal information
 - Relationship to the veteran
 - Education and training details
- Review the form carefully for accuracy.

5 Submit & Receive Certificate of Eligibility (COE)



- Submit application
- Once processed, you will receive your Certificate of Eligibility (COE) by mail or through your VA.gov account.

6 Submit COE to UW-Oshkosh



- Submit a copy of your COE to the UW-Oshkosh Veterans Resource Center.
